Dear Sir/Madam,

I refer to your representations on behalf of Ms. S. Ilacqua, 68/4 Vermont Crescent, Riverwood who is seeking a transfer to other Department of Housing accommodation.

As you may be aware, during October 1989, The Minister announced changes to the Department's transfer policy which limits transfers to tenants for serious medical or disability reasons which are directly affected by their present accommodation, tenants at risk, those facing severe harassment or where the accommodation is severely overcrowded.

She is in extremely need -

You will appreciate a large number of Departmental tenants seek transfer for various reasons and having regard to the very limited supply of dwellings it is necessary to limit transfers to those cases mentioned which are directly affected by the type of accommodation occupied.

Following receipt of your representations, Ms. Ilacqua's request for rehousing was carefully considered in the light of her recently completed Application for Rehousing. The request does not meet the new criteria for transfer. It is considered there does not exist severe medical reasons which make relocation essential. Whilst sympathetic to the situation faced by Ms. Ilacqua the request for rehousing must therefore be declined.

However, no objection would be raised if Ms. Ilacqua endeavoured to arrange a mutual exchange of tenancies with another Department tenant provided any such proposal is submitted to the Department in the first instance.

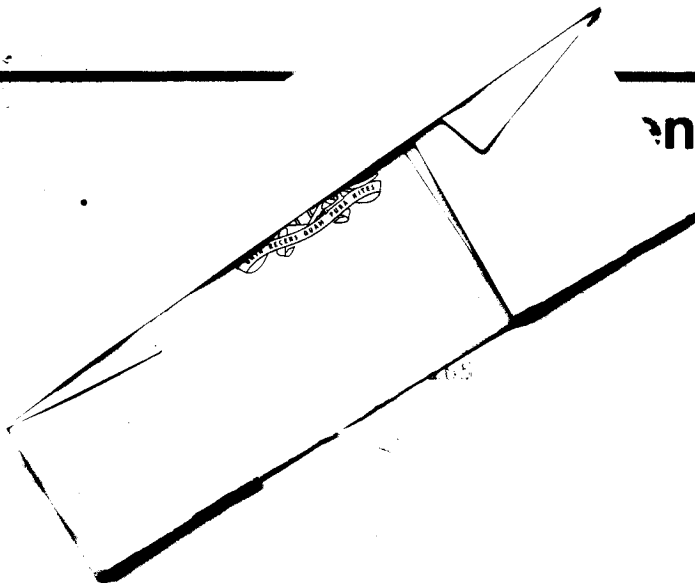


