#### ON THE OCCASION OF HER 80TH BIRTHDAY

## A Tribute to Mamma Lena

Today we celebrate the eightieth birthday of a remarkable fady who has been a comfort, a friend and supporter to thousands of Italians in their time of need. Mamma Lena a unique lady is known to all Italians in Australia, there would not be one Italo-Australian that has not been touched by her many kind and good deeds. Mamma Lena has made more contributions to the Italo-Australian community than most could imagine. Songs have been written and sung about her, poems and books have been produced and numerous

plaques have been presented to her. Mamma Lena's dedicated work has been acknowledged not only by the Italo-Australian community, but also by the Italian and Australian media, the Italian and Australian Governments as well as prominent dignitaries such as Mr Menzies, Mr Fraser, Mr Whitlam, Mr John Laws, Mr Askin plus many more too numerous to list.

Mamma Lena in 1967 was awarded "The Cross of the Knighthood" as Italy recognised her valuable work for migrants and Australia thus awarding her with its second highest honour, Mamma Lena is also the first Italo-Australian woman ever to be made a Member of the British Empire (M.B.E.) and recently, June 1994, she was presented with a gold medal by CO.AS. IT. Comitate Assistenza Italiano – Fundraising Committee in recognition for the contributions to date, as well as the present contributions she continues to make to the Italo-Australian community.

Mamma Lena was born Lena Morelli in Azzone di Scalve (Bergamo) on the 9th July, 1914. Both her parents died when she was a child. She ended her studies at the Ca' Foscari – The University of Venice.

In 1940 she married Dino Gustin, they had three children Alberto, Rosalba and Roberto, Dino was away at the war and Mamma Lena had to raise the children on her own and deal with the sudden death of their dearest first born Alberto aged 4 years old.

In 1956 Dino, Mamma Lena and Family migrated to Australia. Upon arrival they found a lack of services to assist newly arrived as well as established migrants to cope with the traumas of charge in life styles in their new environment. After only six months in Australia Dino and Mamma Lena set out to do something about this sad situation.

Mamma Lena started writing in the "La Fiamma" Newspaper taking out 3 pages she set about responding to readers on their problems, informed them of various activities and advised them on various social problems, cooking, sewing tips and other interesting topics; Mamma Lena did this for approximately 8 years.

Mamma Lena started her Italian radio programme together with Dino as producer on 2SM, 2CH, 2KY, then 2SER. Now they were able to reach into the homes of the Italians in Australia and was possible to advise them of services available, give them news of their homeland and entertain them with music, competitions and organising many events and annual balls for the Italian community.

Her programme also promoted many Italian businesses and personalities. Mamma Lena's radio programs were what all Italians would look forward to daily. Letters poured in from the listeners to confide their anguish, desperation, their pining for the motherland, their loneliness and depressions. They would plead for her advice on general matters to the more personal ones. The Italo-Australians depended on her for every aspect of support. From then onwards she was considered a mother to all Italo-Australians an icon, hence the endearing title "MAMMA LENA"

In 1978 Mamma Lena was made a member of the National Women's Advisory Council for a period of 2 years, attending meetings which took her all over Australia.

As Italians were still migrating to Australia, Mamma Lena visited immigration camps where she would deliver purcels, find accommodation and employment for them. For more established migrants she would personally accompany them to various government offices and doctors. They would go by taxi more often than not, at her own expense. She encouraged them to learn english, knowing that most families worked day and night, she would send those who wanted to learn English learning kits and information on where they were able to study English through correspondence.

To the new generation of Australians with Italian background Mamma Lena has also contributed and continues doing so through her promotion for the teaching of Italian in our school system. In 1992 Mamma Lena set up a petition with many thousand of signatures to lobby the Federal Government to have Italian as a priority language in our schools. Mamma Lena also taught Italian for 2 years through the Evening College at Ashfield.

Mamma Lena's dedication to the Sorella Radio Childcare Centre has been phenomenal. Through her hard fought efforts her dream of establishing a multicultural child care centre was established 1984. Through growing needs there is a necessity to expand the existing facilities to accommodate the growing number of families requesting its services.

To list all of Mamma Lena's achievements in a few lines is impossible however-you can read the full history of Mamma Lena's achievements in the book titled "70 Years of Life in Two Countries: Italy and Australia" by Dino Gustin. The book, released in 1988, can be found in most libraries.

Mamma Lena our celebrations for you on your 80th birthday is a small token to show you how we the Italo-Australian Community feel about you our friend, our companion and our "MAMMA LENA".

Dear Mamma Lena with great pride we wish you a very Happy 80th Birthday and a big "THANK YOU" for all the work you have done and continue to do for the Italians who have made Australia their home.

#### A Double Celebration

Today we celebrate the 80th Birthday party for a very well known and much loved member of the Italo-Australian community "Mamma Lena" (Lena Gustin).

I am sure you are all well aware of her achievements, however just as a reminder I would like to give you some insight into the life of this very popular lady.

Manuna Lena commenced her work for Italian immigrants as a journalist and radio announcer in 1956 on the Ethnic Programmes of radio stations such as 2SM, 2CH, 2KY and 2SER, a career which spanned a total 29 years. During this time, she was in many instances, the only source of information for many non English speaking people and in many cases provided much more than just "news reading".

An active member of the Italo-Australian community and The National Women's Auxiliary Council in Canberra among many other things, Mamma Lena was also awarded an MBE by the Queen in 1968 and a Knighthood by the Italian Government for her endless efforts with the Italo-Australian community. Not one to let age get in her way, Mamma Lena continues to help and participate in the community to this day. She is also an Honourary Member of our Club, and what would Wednesday's Bingo be without "Mamma Lena".

Manuma Lena had a dream, since 1963, to one day help build a "Child Care Centre", and this dream was fulfilled on the 29th April 1984 with the opening of the "Sorella Radio Child Care Centre" in Fairfield, N.S.W. which caters to the needs of the very young community members.

Coincidentally, the 9th July (yesterday) was also the 34th
